- **TICKETS:** Previews, first week; \$37 & \$27 for Wednesday and Thursday at 8pm, \$56 & \$46 for Saturday 8pm. Regular prices, \$50 & \$40 for Tuesday-Thursday 8pm and Sunday 7pm, \$57 & \$47 for Friday 8pm and Sunday 2pm, \$62 & \$52 for Saturday 8pm.

Available Ticket Discounts

- **Woolly's "25 AND UNDER" program offers \$15 tickets** to all Woolly Mammoth-produced subscription performances (this applies to *Clybourne Park*) for patrons age 25 or under; ID required. Tickets can be purchased in advance or at the door.
- **PAY-WHAT-YOU-CAN (PWYC)** is available during preview performances of all mainstage productions. PWYC for *Clybourne Park* is scheduled for Monday, March 15 and Tuesday, March 16 at 8pm. Tickets are available for purchase starting at 6:30pm each evening; lines begin forming at 6pm. Two tickets per person limit, cash or check ONLY.
- **STAMPEDE SEATS** offers a limited number of side balcony tickets at \$15. These are available for all performances and only sold 2 hours prior to showtime, in-person only.
